Financial Overview/PTO Purchases Updates

- 1. Technology/Interactive Boards Michelle Yocum presented a demonstration of the new interactive boards, purchased by the PTO. The boards have arrived and have been installed into 12 classrooms. Our goal is to get them into each classroom over the next couple of years, specifically with help from the district. These boards have built in sound, tablets that are able to mirror computer or other tablet devices and are able to connect to internet. Substitute teachers will be able to access teachers lesson plans with these boards. Both teachers and students are excited for these new technology tools!
- 2. Playground Equipment Deb Hossenlopp reminded parents about the petition that came from fourth grade students regarding the addition of a tire swing to the playground. She has looked into the tire swing option but is finding it to be expensive. The PTO Board is unsure if this is the best addition due to cost, safety, and the amount of kids it can serve at one time. PTO will continue to research the best options to update the playgrounds.

3. Furniture Update - PTO is purchasing 18 new chairs for the teachers' lounge, as the current ones are cracking and breaking. They will also purchase new chairs for the front office and lobby area. Jen Hirons, from Modern Spaces (Willis parent) is donating \$1500 and her time to get these ordered for us. They will be ordered in the upcoming week and should take 3-4 weeks to be delivered.

- Father/Daughter Dance Denise West reported that things were going smoothly as we approach the dance. She will need volunteers Friday from drop off to the end of school. Volunteers can help all day or any amount of time they can give. Denise has someone in the county looking into fire marshal capacity of all schools out East to give us ideas for next year.
