Welcome

1. Each PTO Board Member introduced themselves and provided attendees with some background information.

Financial Overview

- 1. Deb Hossenlopp reviewed financials and made attendees aware that financials are posted online at the PTO's website.
- 2. PTO Purchases- The PTO purchased an air purifier for the clinic, hand sanitizing stations, Making Meaning workbooks, banners, coffees and pastries for teachers on 1st day of school, new Janitorial cart, Cranium Core reading program for Mr. Violette and a Cricut that can be used by volunteers
